



8th European Congress of Mathematics – 8ECM

Between **5 and 11 July 2020**, the 8th European Congress of Mathematics (8ECM) will be held in **Portorož, Slovenia** which will be the **world's largest event in mathematics in 2020**. The European Congress of Mathematics is organized by the European Mathematical Society (EMS) every four years and is the second largest event of mathematics in the world.

[European Mathematical Society](#) is a learned society representing mathematicians throughout Europe. It promotes the development of all aspects of mathematics in Europe, in particular mathematical research, relations of mathematics to society, relations to European institutions, and mathematical education. The EMS has its members in around 60 national mathematical societies in Europe, 40 mathematical research centres and departments, and 3000 individuals.

EMS Congresses are held from 1992 when the 1st European Congress of Mathematics took place in **Paris, France**.

Since 1992 European Congress of Mathematics was held every four years in different parts of Europe:

- 2nd European Congress of Mathematics, **Budapest**, July 22 - 26, 1996
- 3rd European Congress of Mathematics, **Barcelona**, July 10 - 14, 2000
- 4th European Congress of Mathematics, **Stockholm**, June 27 - July 2, 2004
- 5th European Congress of Mathematics, **Amsterdam**, July 14 - 18, 2008
- 6th European Congress of Mathematics, **Krakow**, July 2 - 7, 2012
- 7th European Congress of Mathematics, **Berlin**, July 18 - 22, 2016

The organization of the 8ECM in 2020 was entrusted to [University of Primorska](#), in cooperation with University of Ljubljana, University of Maribor, Institute of Mathematics, Physics and Mechanics (IMFM), the Society of Mathematicians, Physicists and Astronomers (DMFA), The Slovenian Discrete and Applied Mathematics Society (SDAMS), and Abelium d.o.o.

Between 1500 – 2000 researchers and doctoral students from across Europe and the globe are expected to attend 8ECM, along with many educational institutions, organizations, publishing houses and various companies searching for future co-workers or research cooperation.

The 8th European Congress of Mathematics has a strong support, both in the International and Slovene scientific community. We are honoured that **His Excellency Mr. Borut Pahor, president of the Republic of Slovenia**, has also recognized the significance of this event and took over the **honorary patronage of the 8ECM**.
